PROGRAM DETAIL

On this Phuket day trip, you will discover the diverse communities inhabiting the south of Thailand. Your multi-cultural Phuket tour will begin on Siray Island, home to the Moken people, also known as the sea gypsies, an animist community, who live solely off fishing. Around 25% of Phuket’s residents are Muslim and based around the east coast of the island. Before visiting one of its most representative villages and mosques of the island, you will stop to try the famous Roti and Copi (a local coffee and a sweet). In the Kathu district, home to the oldest Chinese shrine on Phuket Island, you will discover the remnants of the tin mining industry that brought the Chinese migrants to Phuket in the 18th century. Finally, the day ends with some local cuisine, a favourite of the local people: Hokkien Noodle Soup.
